The Facilities Assessment Task Force toured Canutillo Middle School and gathered in small groups to further discuss the four areas of concentration voted upon the members.

Group 1: Elementary Needs

Recommendations for consideration:

- **Construction of elementary school in the Enchanted Hills subdivision.**

Group 2: Secondary Needs

Recommendations for consideration:

- Construction of middle school in the Enchanted Hills subdivision.
- Re-construction and relocation of Canutillo Middle School.
- Construction of brick-and-mortar Northwest Early College High School.
- Construction of Career & Technical Education wing at Canutillo High School.

Group 3: Deferred Maintenance

Recommendations for consideration:

- Updating of HVAC systems at all campuses not slated for replacement/reconstruction.
- New roofs for campuses that need it and that are not slated for replacement/reconstruction.
- Allotment of \$1 million to address deferred maintenance on the facilities assessment list for Garcia, Damian, Childress, Canutillo and Reyes elementary schools.
- Athletic upgrades at Canutillo High School (baseball/softball lights, scoreboard for football stadium).

Group 4: Safety & Security

Recommendations for consideration:

- Upgrade of District-Wide Video Surveillance System
- Installation of Access-Controlled Systems for all District doors.
- Construction of Safety Vestibules for all campuses that need them and are not slated for reconstruction/replacement.
- Upgrade of Intercom/PA Systems for all campuses that need them and are not slated for reconstruction/replacement.

- Repayment of Canutillo Connect (Apple laptops) Maintenance Tax Notes.
